D., I presented for your consideration some resolutions of respect to his memory, and I will now ask your attention while I sketch briefly his life. Richard Stockton Field was born at Whitehill, in the county of Burlington, New Jersey, on the last day of December, 1803. The history of the family descent is somewhat obscure, but it is certain that he was descended from the same family as John Field, the distinguished English astronomer of the middle of the sixteenth century, who was the first to use the Copernican system as a basis for calculations for practical purposes, in his Ephemeris anni 1557 currentis, juxta Copernici et Reinholdi Canones fideliter per Joannem Field. This work, which was of considerable magnitude, was undertaken at the suggestion of the celebrated Dr. Dee, and...
